Any warranty claim will **not exceed** the amount this part has been invoiced for.

What our Warranty Excludes: (This is a list of what this parts warranty form **does not** cover).

| 1 | Any damage due to non-tradesman like or improper installation , negligence, alteration, accident or improper use, e.g. damage or failure caused by overheating or exceeding the recommended towing or weight capacity . Proper use is stated for all parts in the vehicle owner's manual or handbook. |
| 2 | The warranty is void if the vehicle odometer has been disconnected or the kilometer or mileage reading has been altered. |
| 3 | Any use related to off road use including automotive racing , on or off track or any other type of vehicle competition. Also excluded is any part sold and then later used for racing or competition, including, engine conversions, engines, transmissions, or any other parts or their components. |
| 4 | Any damage caused by lack of proper maintenance as prescribed in the vehicle owner's manual or handbook. Any failure to carry out vehicle maintenance at the recommended service intervals. Any abuse or thrashing of the vehicle the part is fitted to. |
| 5 | Any damage caused when the following items have not been replaced with new or reconditioned ones. Thermostats, frost plugs, water pump, radiator & hoses, oil seals, electrical components & cam belt kits. |
| 6 | Coolant or oil leaks. (It is your responsibility to inspect or replace all seals prior to fitting). Incorrect lubricant & fluid <u>levels and types</u> <u>must be followed</u> as outlined in the handbook or manual. Any failure to comply with the specified <u>levels and types</u> will void this warranty. You must be able to provide proof that you have followed the vehicle manual or handbook recommendations. |
| 7 | Damage as a result of overheating, contamination, lack of or incorrect lubricant, inadequate or blocked transmission cooler or lines. |
| 8 | Damage caused by a turbocharger, supercharger or other such part which is not an approved Ford or Holden part or accessory. |
| 9 | Failure of any ancillary part attached to the engine and supplied free of charge with the engine, including but not limited to alternators, turbos, injector pumps, injectors, glow plugs (our warranty does not cover breakage), idle valves, thermostat housings, oil coolers, EGR valves & coolers. Parts supplied free of charge are not covered by any warranty nor the cost of any consequential damage that is caused by any failure of these parts. |
| 10 | Compatibility , It is the purchaser and/or installers responsibility to ensure any part is compatible prior to fitting. Advanced Parts & Spares Ltd does not cover any costs relating to swapping parts which have not been checked for compatibility or fitted in error. |
| 11 | Very Important for transmissions: Damage caused by incorrect installation of the torque converter. The installer must check correct fitment of the converter into the pump prior to fitting. |
| 12 | Any consequential damage or costs , loss of time, inconvenience, loss of use of the vehicle, towage, or any other economical loss. |
| 13 | Any vehicles that are operated at any time outside of New Zealand . |
| 14 | Any part installed under an existing new vehicle warranty . |

Transmission Check Guide:

It is very important that you or your qualified installer perform the following checks at installation time, after initial running, again the next day and then at subsequent regular intervals thereafter:

1. Check and follow the manual or handbook for the correct transmission fluid level and type.
2. Check that the transmission cooler and lines have been correctly flushed and cleaned before installation.
3. Check that the transmission torque converter has been installed correctly.
4. Check all plugs, sensors and wiring that are connected to this transmission.

Engine Check Guide:

It is very important that you or your qualified installer perform these under hood checks at installation and at subsequent recommended regular intervals:

1. Check and follow the manual or handbook for the correct engine oil level and type.
2. Check all engine coolant levels and add if necessary.
3. Check all belts and hoses for wear and tear and replace as necessary.
4. Check the radiator, all the plugs, wiring and sensors that are connected to this engine.

It is your responsibility to complete, sign and send a copy of this warranty form to Advanced Parts.
